Benjamin Bloom created a
taxonomy of measurable
verbs to help us describe
and classify observable
knowledge, skills,
attitudes, behaviors and
abilities. The theory is

based upon the idea that there are levels of observable actions that indicate something is happening in the brain (cognitive activity.)

Good learning outcomes focus on the application

and integration of the knowledge and skills acquired in a particular unit of instruction (e.g. activity, course program, etc.), and emerge from a process of reflection on the essential contents of a course. More specifically,
