In Chapter 6, you were introduced to the polymers of life and their building block structures, as shown below in Figure 11.1. Recall that the monomer units for building the nucleic acids, DNA and RNA, are the nucleotide bases, whereas the monomers for proteins are amino acids, for carbohydrates are sugar residues, and for lipids are fatty acids or acetyl groups.

Scientific Notation- In which any number can be represented in the form $N \times 10^n$ Where n is an exponent having positive or negative values and N can vary between 1 to 10). e.g. We can write 232.508 as 2.32508×10^2 in scientific notation. Similarly, 0.00016 can be written as 1.6×10^{-4} . Precision refers to the closeness of various measurements for the same quantity.
