Outbreak of early mortality syndrome (EMS) or acute hepatopancreatic necrosis disease (AHPND) in whiteleg shrimp (*Penaeus vannamei*) and black tiger shrimp (*P. monodon*) was first documented in August 2011 in Eastern Thailand. The disease subsequently spread to almost all shrimp production areas in 2012 until the early part of 2016.

21/7/2021 · The early mortality syndrome (EMS) is an emerging shrimp disease more technically known as acute hepatopancreatic necrosis syndrome (AHPNS), caused by unique strain of *Vibrio parahaemolyticus*. The pathogenic bacteria colonize the shrimp gastrointestinal tract and produce a toxin that causes tissue destruction and dysfunction of the shrimp digestive organ (hepatopancrease).

4/9/2018 · The causative agent was reported in 2013 as specific isolates of *Vibrio parahaemolyticus* (VP AHPND) that were later found to harbor a plasmid (pVA) encoding the Pir-like binary toxin genes Pir vp A and Pir vp B. VP AHPND isolates colonize the shrimp stomach and release the binary toxins that cause massive sloughing of tubule epithelial cells followed by shrimp mortality.

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Acute Hepatopancreatic Necrosis Syndrome (AHPNS/AHPND), or Early Mortality Syndrome (EMS) often occurs in black tiger prawn (*Penaeus monodon*) and whiteleg shrimp (*Litopenaeus vannamei*). Shrimp can be infected during the farming process, especially in the period of small shrimp to 45 day-old juveniles.

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
