Emotional wellness uses an ongoing process to continually reflect on the stressors of life in a constructive manner to move forward and create happiness. Because emotional wellness is deeply connected with physical, social, and spiritual wellness, pursuing it often becomes particularly difficult in times of major illness.

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Other ongoing efforts include BCHD's response to emerging diseases like the Zika virus; the essential core public health activities that include investigation and surveillance of foodborne illness, animal bites/rabies, and other infectious diseases such as Legionnaire's disease; and the tracking of HIV, syphilis, gonorrhea, chlamydia, and other sexually-transmitted diseases.

Cancer mortality on the other hand, is 158.3 per year, for every 100K men and women afflicted with a cancerous disease, Sadly, the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society reported that depression and anxiety also typically affect the mental health of people diagnosed with cancer patients.
