2.5 EXHAUST SYSTEM
2.5.1 Provide “critical silencer” to limit the exhaust noise level to 85 dBA at 10 feet in a free field environment, sized to minimize back pressure
2.5.2 When silencers are located further away from the generator than the manufacturer recommends, careful consideration should be given to the exhaust pipe sizes and pressure ratings of all fittings.
