DDP – Delivered Duty Paid: The seller is responsible for delivering the cargo to the final destination,

and paying the import duty, taxes, and customs clearance. Once the cargo arrives at the destination, the responsibility transfers to the buyer, who must cover the costs to unload the shipment. DDP is the only Incoterm that requires the seller to pay all duty charges.
