To cite a book chapter that your professor uploaded to a website, begin with the MLA format template. List the author of the chapter and the chapter title. List the title of the website as the title of the container, not the title of the book, since you found the chapter on the website rather than in the book.

14/1/2021 · In MLA style citations, format a DOI as a link, including “<https://doi.org/>” at the start and then the unique numerical code of the article. <https://doi.org/10.1177/1464700107078139>. DOIs are used mainly when citing journal articles in MLA.

When citing a single chapter from an edited book, the format to use is: Author Surname, Forename. “Chapter Title.”. Edited Book Title, edited by Editor’s Name, Publisher, Year, Page Range.

What Must be Included in PDF Citation MLA . In most cases, MLA PDF citation must be referenced the same way as it would be done with print articles and books. In practice, it means that since a PDF file itself is not a source per se, it represents a medium of telling us what kind of a source has been used.
