27/1/2012 · During (young) adulthood, social ties to labor or marriage and turning points in life can modify trajectories of criminal offending. Based on dynamic theories, such as that of Sampson and Laub, the influence of family ties should diminish in late adolescence and young adulthood as the individual makes other important social ties.

Emerging evidence suggests that the relationship between household chaos and poorer child outcomes may involve other aspects of the home environment, such as maternal sensitivity. In chaotic environments, for example, longitudinal research shows that parents' abilities to read, interpret, and respond to their children's needs accurately are compromised (Vernon-Feagans et al., 2012).

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Adolescence At around the age of 12 or 13 in boys, and 10 or 11 in girls, a big step in development takes place. The reproductive organs and the brain undergo quite large changes. There is often a growth spurt (a sudden, rapid period of growth) at this time. This time of change from childhood to adulthood is called adolescence.

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
