CAUSES OF DECLINE OF The Indus Valley Civilization Introduction: The Harappan Civilization lasted for about one thousand years. Archaeological evidence shows that many of the major cities of the Harappan Civilization, like Harappa, Mohenjo-daro, and Dholavira faced abandonment and decline during the late 3rd and early 2nd millennium B.C.
