It is often used to determine the most cost effective trading methods and the best value by

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Price manipulation A trading strategy is a round-trip trade if $\int_0^T x_t dt = 0$ Definition A price manipulation is a round-trip trade whose expected cost $C[\cdot]$ is negative. You would want to repeat such a trade over and over. If there is price manipulation, there is no optimal strategy.
