If a Flag raising is included in the ceremony, it's recommended an Honor Guard, consisting of at least 7 riflemen, 2 Color Bearers carrying the American Flag (and organization flag, if any), and 2 organization members to raise the Flag, be marched to the flagpole.

- Retire the flag. If there is a small amount of flags to be retired, place them in too. If there are a considerable amount of flags to be retired, retire just one, and wait until after the ceremony to retire the rest.
- Taps as flag burns
- After taps, wait for flag to burn.

The Ceremony for Disposal of Unserviceable Flags is outlined in Resolution No. 440, passed by the 19th National Convention of The American Legion in New York, Sept. 20-23, 1937. The ceremony has been an integral part of American Legion ritual since that date. The resolution reads as follows: WHEREAS, Americanism has been and should continue to be one of the major programs of The American ...

The ceremony involves two color guards, one for the flag currently in use and a special color guard for the flag to be retired from service. Of course, this may be adapted if conditions necessitate. Just before sunset the flag which has been flying all day is retired in the normal ceremonial procedure for that location or group.

31/5/2018 · As well, I have assisted in many flag retirement ceremonies where we respectfully burned our worn flags. Several years ago at a flag retirement ceremony, I recall seeing a fellow veteran rendering a sharp salute as flags burned as the thick acrid smoke wafted by him . His breathing was supported by a small O2 cylinder through a nasal cannula.

As noted in the US Flag Code cited above, the preferred method for retiring a damaged American flag is burning. This doesn't mean that you should toss it into an open fire, however. The flag should be folded military style into the traditional triangle fold, at which point it can then be carefully lowered into the fire while those around take a moment to salute and honor it.
