On January 1, 2001, new state regulations were adopted to comply with these guidelines and the existing water treatment operator certification program was modified accordingly. The new regulations also established a water distribution operator certification program. This program became the Drinking Water Operator Certification Program (DWOCP).

Water distribution systems are classified according to the population served, and require operators to be certified as Distribution Levels 1-4.
